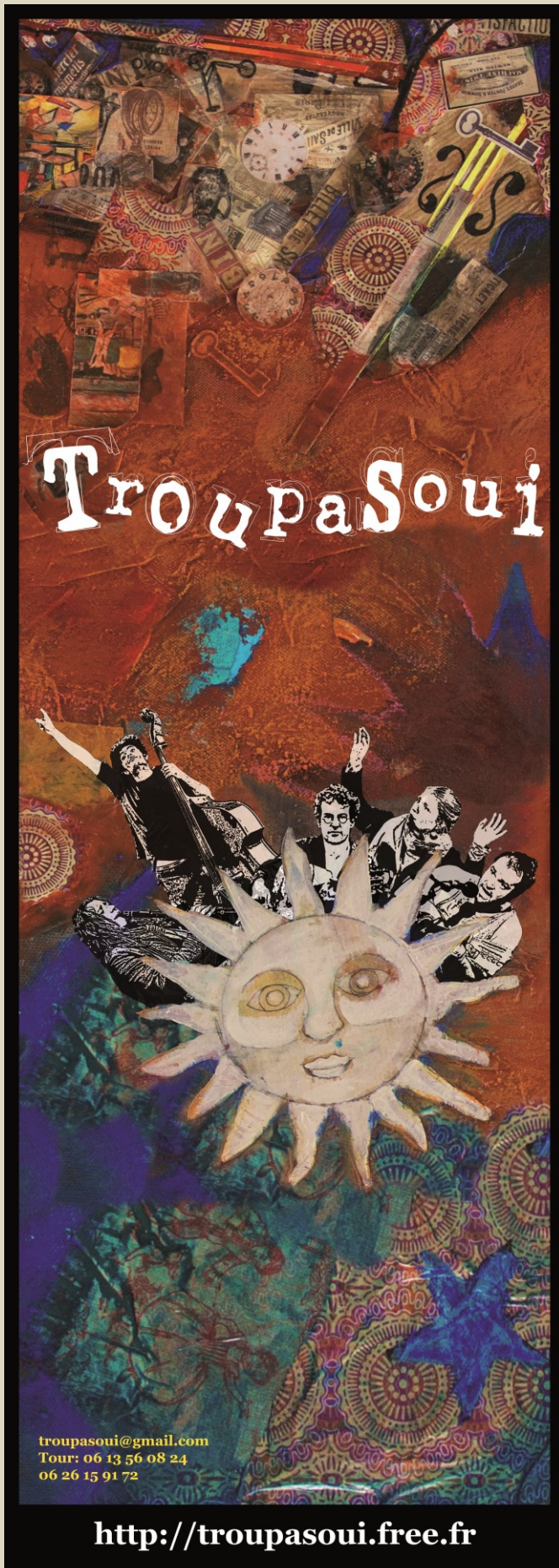


TroupaSoui: **Polyglophonic' Mediterranean & Gypsy style**



These troubadours live and share their joy of playing together since 2007. Over the years, family, friendship, and “souvenirs” become, have woven their links. This blend of complicity game, creations is certainly what gives the group its meaning, with the joy of living together. The musicians have built, with small colored keys original shows and constantly renewed. The register as the band's image has gradually married the influences that are complemented never oppose: gypsy swing, Rembetiko, klezmer, Tzigane, jazz-rock.

After two passages in Greece, TroupaSoui continues to develop his repertoire by taking the traditional music whose members are a breeding ground for their compositions. After "Rue Traverse" published in 2013, the company is preparing a new album fed live past experiences and future woven original arrangements, and reflecting these experienced adventures. Today, 5 musicians offer a unique experience that they call “polyglophonique”, roaming through the language sounds of this world.

Bass, guitar, mandolin, banjo, clarinet and voices, make you trip through emotions, all is put in a show, like a colorful backpack for a trip, open to halt between two emotions, from discovery to discovery. But from their pockets, musical notes that escape and fly away, precede them on the road as light and capricious stones.
